

United States - Customs & Border Protection (US - CBP) has proposed to conduct a training  
titled "INTERNATIONAL AIR CARGO INTERDICTION TRAINING (IACIT-I)" at NACIN, Mumbai campus  
during 27-31, January, 2020

1. IACIT-I is a specialised interactive training in the detection, identification and interdiction of  
contraband in an international airport environment. The proposed course will comprise of classroom  
and practical training in a wide range of enforcement topics, including, targeting, and risk  
management, concealment, methods, inspection techniques, contraband discovery, placement,  
analysis, anti-terrorism and Weapons of Mass Effect (WAMES) for this training programme, trainees  
from US CBP, who possess significant professional expertise in this area will travel to India and  
conduct the program. They will share US CBP's inspection techniques, methodologies and best  
practices. An important part of this programme is the specific emphasis on non-proliferation of  
WAMES, their components and delivery systems.

2. It is requested to nominate 3-4 officers from your zone who have atleast three years of  
experience of working in Customs formations, particularly including 2 officers who are  
handling/supervising examination - related duties at Air Cargo Complexes or Airports. The officers  
should be of ADC/JE, DC/JAC and AOS/Support levels. US - CBP has conveyed the expectation that the

they may also be invited to attend a follow-up training program (IACIT-II). Hence, officers who are
