STANDING ORDER NO. 16/2016

Sub: Customs- RMS in Exports – Examination of export consignments of perishable cargo selected under RMS - reg.

Attention of all concerned officers under Airport and Admin. Commissionerate is invited with regard to the procedure regarding RMS in Exports – Examination of export consignments of perishable cargo selected under RMS, as prescribed down under Board's Circular No. 19/2014-Cus dt.31.12.2014 on the 24x7 Customs clearance and issuance of Standing Order No. 01/2015 dated 02.01.2015 by this Office.

2. The routine physical examination of perishable export cargo to be conducted by the field formation has been exempted by the Board vide Circular No. 08/2007 Cus. dated 22.01.2007 read with Circular No. 12/2013-Cus dated 02.04.2013 subject to certain guidelines. In case, a consignment of perishable cargo for export is selected for examination under RMS, waiver from physical examination can be considered on case to case basis as follows:

- ❖ The shipments of Customs/Central Excise sealed frozen or refrigerated cargo, the exporter may approach AC/DC (Export) for waiver in terms of the Board's Circulars.
- ❖ The AC/DC (Export) if no prior intelligence/ information is available and that it is a routine examination may waive physical examination keeping in mind factors like history, background, antecedents of both Exporter and Customs Broker including whether they are local or outstation or transit time taken after sealing container and if it is a case of first time exporter
- ❖ For consignments for which physical examination is waived, the documents / container/seal verification shall be carried out.
- ❖ If examination is warranted, it shall be carried out expeditiously and customs clearance be given on the same day itself unless there is contravention of customs laws/Allied Acts. The procedure for clearance as provided under Para 4 of Facility Intimation No.13.2013 dated 12.12.2013 is to be followed.

3. Perishable cargo brought to Export Shed in late hours/ holidays will be dealt as follows:

- (i) Preventive Officer (IFO/EFO) will register the Shipping Bill of Perishable Cargo & assist.
- (ii) Examination/Inspection report on the basis of RMS instruction, have to be entered into the report columns/departmental comments by Preventive Officers.
- (iii) Supdt. of Customs, Preventive Officers (IFO/EFO) will follow CCR and other RMS instruction during examination/inspection and will give LEO.

4. In case of any difficulties in the implementation of this Facility Intimation, the same may be brought to the notice of the Dy./Asstt. Commissioner of Customs (Exports), Air Cargo Complex, NSCBI AIRPORT, Kolkata- 700 052.
