In this regard, this is to inform you that generally all shipping bills, for which EGMs have been filed is automatically transmitted to DGFT server through systems. In case of any problem, Exporters/CHA may contact to the Superintendent of the Customs (EDI) of customs formation or Appraising officer (Export Group) posted at ACC.


It is found the Xerox copy of your letter no. Nil dated 12.01.2018 wherein you had applied for re-transmit of the certain Shipping Bills to DGFT server as they are not being viewed in DGFT server that you had made RTI application just on the next day of your application for transmission without giving reasonable time to locate. The letter dated 12.01.2018 referred above, which contains the Asstt. Commissioner's allocation of the job to the appraising officer (Export Group).

It is also not understood where from you enclosed the Xerox copy of the office record because that office record is found to be traceless. It appears that your staff/officer has taken back the letters meant for this office to work.

Further, on scrutiny of all shipping bills from the system, it is found that almost all Shipping Bills, there is EGM error because the EGM date of flight and date of LEO are not synchronous. In such circumstance, you are requested to visit this office and meet the Superintendent of Customs (EDI) along with Shipping Bill and relevant documents in order to sort out your problem.

If you are aggrieved with the above information, you may prefer an appeal against the same to the Appellate Authority i.e Shri Amarendra Narayan, Jt. Commissioner of Customs (Airport & Admn.), Custom House, 15/1 Strand Road, Kolkata-700 001 within 30 (thirty) days from the date of receipt of this letter.
