Subject:- Application seeking information under Right to Information Act, 2005:-reg;

Please refer to your application dated 15.03.2017, seeking information under RTI Act, 2005, which is transferred to this office by CPIO & Asst. Commissioner of Customs (RTI Cell) vide his letter dated 05.05.2017 issued under office F. No. S (RTI-05)-05/2017(A&A) invoking the provisions of Section 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005. The said letter dated 05.05.2017 was received in this office on 08.05.2017.

The point wise reply to the information sought for in respect of Air Cargo complex, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata is as follows:-

Point No. 1- Not related to this office. As this office do not hold any export/import fair.

Point No. 2- As per Para 2.01 of Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2015-20:- Exports and Imports are 'Free' except when regulated by way of 'prohibition', 'restriction' or 'exclusive trading through State Trading Enterprises (STEs)' as laid down in Indian Trade Classification (Harmonised System) [ITC (HS)] of Exports and Imports. The list of 'Prohibited', 'Restricted' and 'STE' items can be viewed by clicking on 'Downloads' at <http://dgft.gov.in>.

Para 2.17 of FTP 2015-20:- states that direct or indirect export and import of following items, whether or not originating in Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), to / from, DPRK is 'Prohibited':- All items, materials, equipment, goods and technology including as set out in lists in documents INFCIRC/254/Rev.11/Part 1 and INFCIRC/254/ Rev.8/Part 2 (IAEA documents), S/2012/947, S/2009/364 and S/2006/853 (UN Security Council documents) and Annex III to UN Security Council resolution 2094 (2013) which could contribute to DPRK's nuclear-related, ballistic missile-related or other weapons of mass destruction-related programmes; Luxury goods, including but not limited to the items specified in Annex IV to UN Security Council resolution 2094 (2013).

Para 2.18 of FTP 2015-20 states that direct or indirect export and import of all items, materials, equipment, goods and technology which could contribute to Iran's enrichment-related, reprocessing
